

DMCA Takedown Notice

Dear DMCA Agent,

I am writing to formally request a DMCA takedown concerning the unauthorized use and fraudulent activities being conducted across various services by a server associated with the domain **6b6t.org**. This server is being used to promote a fake and deceptive Minecraft server that is misrepresenting itself as the legitimate **6b6t** Minecraft server, which we own under **6b6t.ca**.

For over eight years, **6b6t.ca** has existed as the authentic Minecraft server, building a loyal community and distinctive reputation. However, **6b6t.org**, which was originally owned by our company Xera and subsequently stolen, has been running a fraudulent copy of our server for the past two years. This server is using our brand name, logos, and other intellectual property across multiple services, including but not limited to DDoS protection, hosting, and Discord, to deceive players and cause confusion.

The actions of the **6b6t.org** server and its current owners have caused significant financial damage to **Xera**, the company that owns both **6b6t.ca** and **8b8t.me**. Their misuse of the **6b6t** name and the fraudulent operation of a server under this name have resulted in a substantial loss in revenue, severely hindering the growth and success of our legitimate servers. Our efforts to revive the original server in 2022 and 2023 were undermined by these actions, preventing us from fully capitalizing on our brand and community.

I have a good faith belief that the use of the content and branding across these services is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law. Under penalty of perjury, I confirm that the information provided in this notification is accurate, and I am authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the exclusive rights being infringed. I hereby request that you remove or disable the fraudulent server and its associated services, including any DDoS protection and hosting providers, to prevent further unauthorized use and distribution of our intellectual property.
